Mr. J. G. Kolfage has won the distinction of being the first mayor of Amherstburg, having defeated Mr. Twomey on Monday. Both gentlemen had served the town previously as councillor and reeve, and either of them would have discharged the duties of mayor satisfactorily. As Mr. Kolfage is much the older man, many electors thought he ought to be the first choice. For the reeveship there was a spirited contest between Mr. Balfour and Mr. McGee, the late reeve, resulting in the election of the former. Mr. Crimmins was elected deputy-reeve, beating the late incumbent, Mr. Brett, Mr. Jones and Mr. Green. The successful candidates for the council are—First Ward, Messrs. Geo. Middleditch, A. Bailey and C. W. Thomas. Second Ward, Messrs. Bell, Bertramand Mofris. Third Ward, Messrs. West, Wilkinson and Cadaret.
